



QUICK GUIDE TO POOL MAINTENANCE

The secret of keeping your pool in perfect condition is good preventive maintenance. This is a quick guide to show you how.

DAILY:

1. Check the level of residual free chlorine, and keep it at between 0.5 and 2 ppm.
2. Check the pH of the water. It should be between 7.2 and 7.6.
3. Keep the water clean of leaves and insects.

WEEKLY:

1. Clean away the dirt that has accumulated in the skimmers, scrub the sides of the pool and then clean the floor with the pool vacuum.
2. Wash and rinse the filter and wash the pre-filter of the pump (motor).
3. If necessary, replace the multi-action chlorine tablets in the skimmers.
4. If you don't use multi-action chlorine tablets, add an anti-algae as a preventive measure.

REMEMBER:

1. Make sure the water level is correct (approximately half way up the skimmer opening).
2. Check the chlorine and pH levels every time you replace the water in the pool, adjusting them if necessary.
3. When it rains, repeat the checks mentioned above, changing the pH and chlorine parameters if necessary.
4. If you use an automatic dosing unit or a saltwater chlorinator, check it and keep it in perfect working order.
